Martha Cassell wills her ability to sing to Larry Cox and her ability to get along with teachers to Charles Neel and Larry Hanshew.

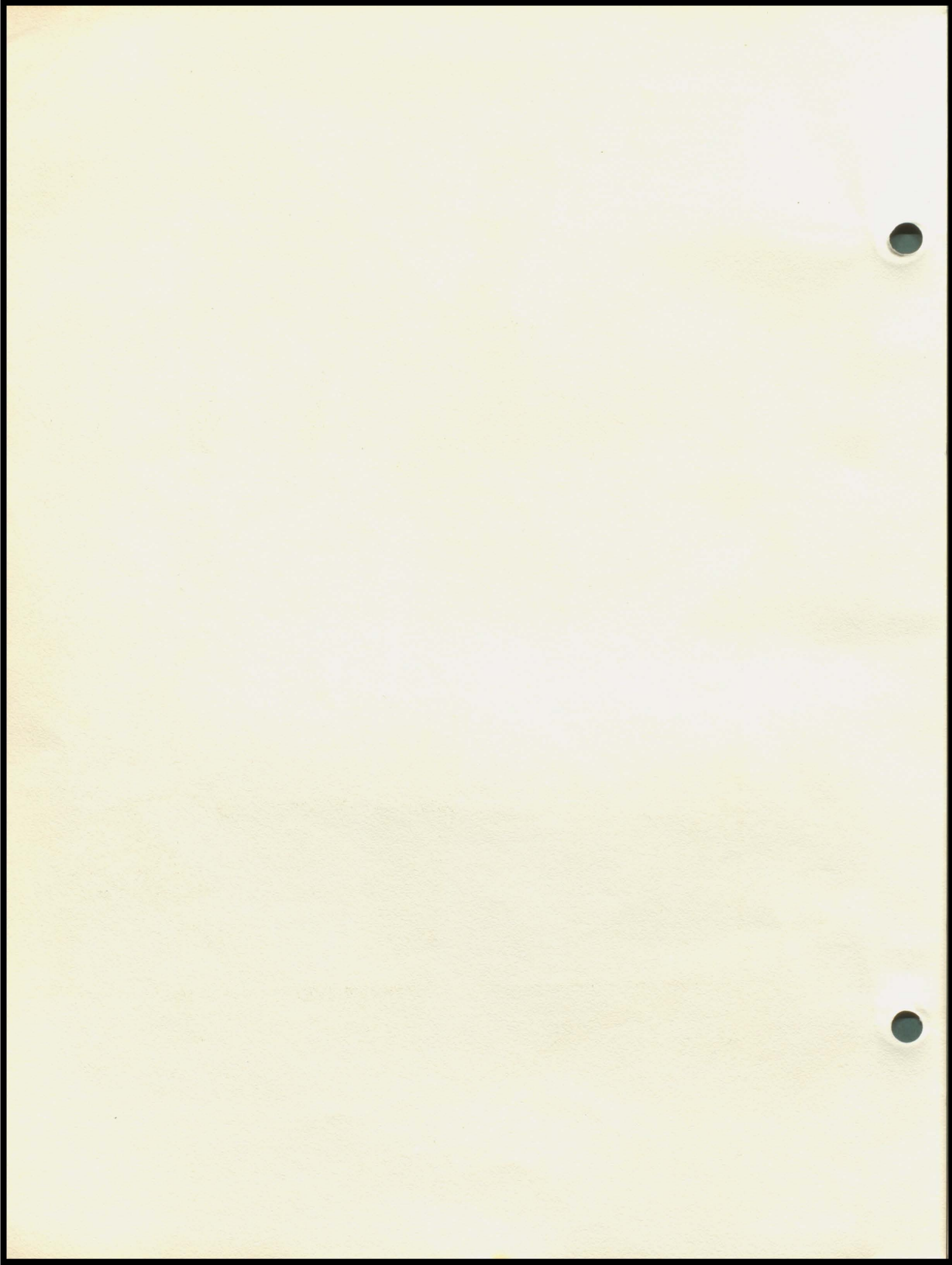
Johnny Ingram leaves his glasses to Mary Scott, until she gets her own. To Richard Cregar he leaves luck to be the only boy in class.

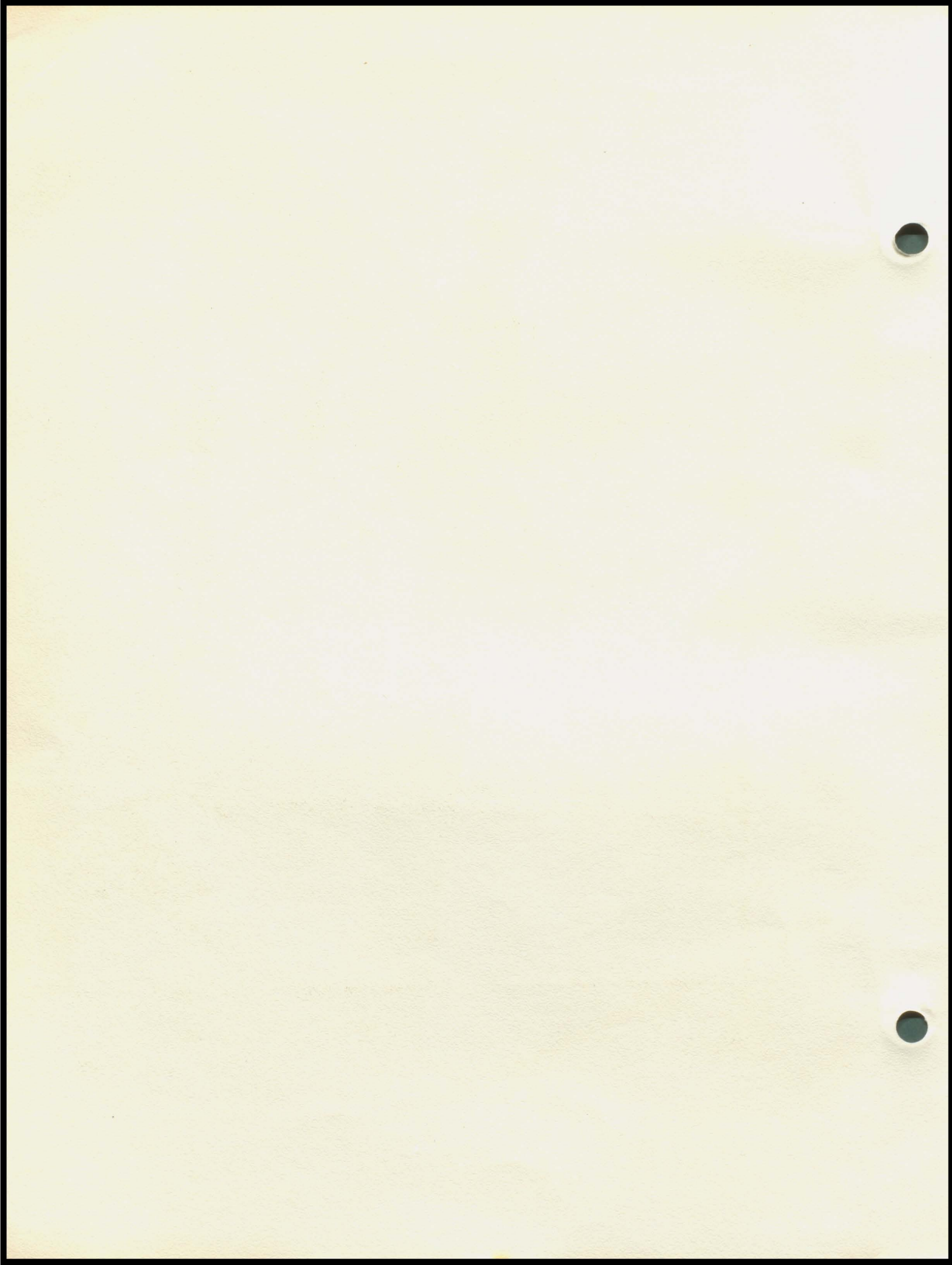
## *Varsity Basketball*
